## **Falcon Stadium Entry Policy**

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Early arrival is highly suggested. For safety and security, please note size restriction and types of bags allowed inside Falcon Stadium. Be prepared to show keys, cell phones, or other metal related items during screening/metal detection process.

NOTE: Do not leave any items at gates; return items to your vehicle or dispose.

- Air Force Academy North and South entry gates and parking lots open 4 hours prior to kickoff.
  - Stadium Entry Gates and Ticket Booths open 2 hours prior to kickoff.
- Persons/personal belongings are subject to search. Entry will be denied if you elect not to consent
- APPROVED BAGS: (1) Clear Bag per ticket holder that is plastic/vinyl/PVC, not exceeding 12"x12"x12".
  - Small clutch bag or fanny pack no larger than 5.5" x 7.5"
- <u>FOOD:</u> Food is permitted, but must be displayed in a transparent 1-gallon zip lock bag. <u>Note</u>: Only (1) one-gallon transparent zip lock bag per ticket holder.
- <u>BEVERAGES</u>: Factory-sealed transparent soft plastic water bottles, 24 oz. or less is the only beverage permitted. <u>Note</u>: Beverage exceptions are made for medical conditions and infants. Fans may also bring in an empty soft transparent water bottle for the purpose of filling their bottle with water inside stadium. (24 oz./less)

## • PROHIBITED ITEMS:

- o Illegal substances: Note Marijuana is an illegal substance on Federal property
- Weapons: i.e. firearms, knives of any type, pepper spray and other aerosols, stun-guns, key rings/key
  chains for self-defense, any item that may be used as a projectile or deemed unsafe by venue Mgmt.
- Alcohol, glass containers, bottles/cans, aerosol sprays, hard sided coolers (or Nalgene) plastic bottles
- Sunscreen: Sunscreen is permissible in 6-ounce tubes or less. (No bottles or aerosol sprays)
- <u>BAGS:</u> Backpacks, Camera/Binocular Cases, Bota Bags, Camelbacks, Mesh Bags, Large Printed Bags, Large Purse, Tinted Plastic Bags, Diaper Bag, Oversized Tote Bags
- Laser pointers, fireworks, or any item deemed unsafe by security personnel
- o Any unapproved Banners/Signs (No signs larger than 18" x 24")
- **Output** Open of the PETS: (Other than ADA Compliant Service Animals)
- O Sticks, bats, poles, umbrellas, footballs, Frisbees, balls or inflatable balls
- Artificial noisemakers of any kind
- o Baby seats, Large Strollers----(Collapsible umbrella strollers are permitted)
- Any item that cannot be readily inspected
- No flash photography
- No Smoking or Tobacco of any kind---(Includes vapor cigarettes)
- Seatbacks wider than 18 inches (no excessive pockets, concealable areas, or protruding arm rests)
- <u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: There is no available storage of prohibited items. Please take back to your vehicle
- Express lines available for spectators entering the stadium with nothing to be searched.
- Reentry is permitted at gates 3, 6, and 9 only. Cadets must have Military ID to regain entry
- Post-game tailgating will close  $\underline{2}$  hours after the conclusion of each football game.

## FAN CODE OF CONDUCT

\*The following behavior will not be tolerated and may lead to automatic ejection\*

- Foul, obscene, offensive or abusive language, gestures or actions that are disruptive or illegal in nature
- Ethnic intimidation of any kind. i.e. slurs based on race, gender, sexual orientation, religion or creed
- Intoxication or signs of alcohol/substance impairment that results in irresponsible behavior.
- Interfering with the game or throwing any object onto the field or in the venue premises.
- Verbal/ physical harassment of home/visiting team, game mgmt. fans, game officials.
- Fighting
- Conduct that endangers/threatens the safety of others
- Indecent exposure or the wearing of obscene or indecent clothing.
