Cadet Primary Care Clinics

➤ **Cadet Medicine Clinic:**

- Hours of Operation: M–F, 0700–1630 (closed 1050–1150 for lunch)
 - Closed weekends, Federal Holidays & second Thursday of the month for training
- Primary Care
- Sports Medicine Primary Care for IC Athletes, MSK care for all cadets
 - Concussion Care
- Adolescent Medicine
 - Behavioral Health, Eating Disorders, Sexual Health
- Preventative Medicine
 - Tracks trends and advises on matters pertaining to trainee health and well-being
 - Travel Medicine
 - Immunizations
- IDMT Training Platform
 - Physician Extenders
- Cadet Case Management
 - Coordination of complex off-base care and hospitalizations

➤ **Flight Medicine Clinic:**

- Hours of operation: 0700-1100 & 1300-1600 Mon-Thurs, 0700-0900 & 1300-1600 Fridays
- Closed on weekends, Federal holidays and the 2nd Thursday of every month
- Instructor pilots and cadets with Rated AFSCs receive care here
- Return to Flying Status: Call flight medicine at 719-333-5950 to schedule an appointment

Cadet Medicine Clinic

There are 2 ways to schedule appointments:

1) Schedule appointments online via the MHS Genesis Patient Portal:

- Send messages to the healthcare team via the Secure Messaging link. Please type in your desired clinic into the “TO” box in order to send them a message directly.

- Review previous medical encounter notes, labs, radiology reports, immunizations, check medications and request refills

2) Schedule appointments by calling the Access to Care Line (719-524-2273, Option 1)

- A booking protocol is utilized to guide scheduling
- Appointment Clerks may also send communication to the healthcare team
 - Messages are entered in the patient’s medical record through the clinic’s pools
 - These pools are continuously monitored by the nursing staff and addressed ASAP



Cadet Medicine Clinic

- **Walk-in Services (no appointment needed)**
 - Respiratory Infection (COVID, flu, etc.) M–F, 0700–1100
 - Sexually Transmitted Infection (STI) M–F, 0700–1630
 - Urinary Tract Infection (UTI) M–F, 0700–1630
 - Concussion M–F, 0700–1630
 - Immunizations Tu/Th, 0800–1100 & 1300–1500; F, 0800–1100



Cadet Medicine Clinic

After Hours Care

- **Emergency:**
 - Dial 911 or go to the nearest Emergency Room
 - An authorization/referral is NEVER required for emergency care
- **Urgent Care:**
 - During duty hours: cadets must have prior authorization/referral to receive care from an Urgent Care facility. Failure to receive authorization will result in a Point of Service charge and you will be responsible for the bill.
 - After duty hours: cadets do not require prior authorization/referral. It's always a good idea to use the MHS Nurse Advice Line (open 24 hours daily) at 1-800-874-2273, Option 1.
- **Routine Care:**
 - Not authorized outside of the network unless a referral is placed by the PCM.
- Cadets are required to follow up in Cadet Medicine within the next business day after discharge
