





Regional Coordinator Responsibilites

- *Each Regional Coordinator will lead a team of people from their parent clubs in fundraising, organizational efforts, and support at USAFA during the event.
- *Regional Coordinators are required to be present at parent's weekend arriving early enough to be available on August 29 to meet with your region and must also be able to assist with a shift at the TOH table during the parent's weekend Information Fair at Arnold Hall.
- *Coordinate a monthly meeting with your region and participate In a monthly meeting with the board.
- *Each Regional Coordinator will need to provide a region banner

Many parents can support throughout the year but only a limited number will be needed and/or allowed during the actual event due to Arnold Hall fire code. 2023 served 3000 cadets. throughout the evening.



Rules of Engagement for the USAFA TOH 2025

- 1. The regional experience must represent the whole region.
- 2. The regional plan will be voted on by all of the USAFA Parent Clubs in the region.
- 3. Regional coordinators will seek volunteers from all parent clubs in their region. Each region will determine how many volunteers they need to fulfill the regional experience. The TOH Board will have final approval for the number of volunteers that each region requests.
- 4. Each region will have 2 games/activities, not lasting more than 2 minutes each. Each activity/experience will need to have a minimum of 3 stations.
- 5. All food served must be small portion size and be available as a pickup-and-go item for 2500 cadets.
- 6. Each region offers a set of giveaways that must not cost more than \$10 each and are not gifted to the cadets. They are available to all cadets.
- 7. Each region will provide a minimum of 2 raffle prizes valued at below \$250. There is no maximum number of raffle prizes that a region can donate. These will be raffled at the end of the night to those cadets who finished the Exploration.
- 8. Each region will need to provide an example of a regional beer, a regional adult drink, and a regional Non-Alcoholic drink to be served at Deployed Hap.
- 9. Individual parent clubs may not distribute gifts at the USAFA TOH event.
