SUBJECT: USAFA Transition to Health Protection Condition Alpha (HPCON-A)

1. Due to the reduced risk of COVID-19 infection at USAFA, I am directing the transition to HPCON-A effective 10 March 2022. This memorandum rescinds and replaces references (a), (b), (c), (d).

2. HPCON-A allows for 100% workplace occupancy. Mission Elements will continue to assess COVID-19 impacts and determine the appropriate posture for the return of their workforce.

3. Department of Defense Force Health Protection guidance currently remains in effect to include isolation, quarantine, physical distancing for unvaccinated, travel, and meetings. All COVID-19 policy will continue to be adjusted as we move towards an endemic phase of the pandemic.

4. Please continue measures to fight COVID-19 spread on our installation, stay home when you are sick, get tested if symptomatic, wear a mask if symptomatic and follow CDC recommendations for isolation and quarantine.
