Who are our volunteer AOG Parents' Club Mentors?

 Volunteers who have held parents' club leadership positions and can share ideas and resources to help all clubs be successful.

The USAFA AOG Parent Ambassador Mentoring Program matches parents' club volunteer mentors with clubs who are interested in participating.

The program is available and provided, at no cost, to all USAFA Parents' Clubs.

How it Works





How Parents' Club Mentors and Mentees are matched

Prior to being matched, all mentors and mentees will go through an interview process to determine the best fit for both. During this time, we get to know mentors and mentees and learn about their personality and values so that we can match them with someone they will enjoy spending time with.

What to Expect From a Mentoring Session

Mentors and mentees will get to know each other and will identify strengths and weaknesses of the parents' club.

Together they will set simple, achievable goals to accomplish through the mentorship program.

A typical mentoring session will include the following:

- Highlight Parents' Club needs
- Brainstorm ideas and opportunities
- Show where resources can be found
- Plan activities to help the parents' club work towards their goal
- Schedule next mentoring session and share contact information to foster communication
