

- Accredited SERE program
 - S-V98-A (Long Term Survival and Evasion)
 - S-V85-A (Emergency Parachuting Water Survival Training)
 - No resistance and escape training (RT "top-off" at Fairchild)
- 21-day program, hands-on focus
 - Difficult no hazing
 - Up to 400 cadets each summer period
 - Flights/elements have different schedules rotate training/site usage

Ops Air Force/Space Force: 2° summer program focusing and orienting USAFA cadets on Air and Space Force missions, organizational structure, and culture through direct exposure to and experience with Air and Space Force units.

- Two-week program
 - Schedule and events depend on location/unit mission and base director
- CONUS and OCONUS (no "deployed" locations)
- Jointly operated USAFA and AFROTC program
 - AFROTC generally follows a different schedule
