Service commitment: In accordance with 10 U.S.C. 9348 and AFI 36-2107, all Service Academy Graduates entering active duty will incur a 5 year service commitment and an additional concurrent service commitment depending on the type of training or schooling (scholarships) they receive. For instance, members of the Class of 2019 who attend pilot training incur an active duty service commitment of ten years after earning their wings. Following successful completion of training, combat system operators (navigators), remotely piloted aircraft (RPA) sensor operators and airborne battle managers (ABMs) incur a six year commitment. For example, Service Academy Graduates completing ABM training would incur two service commitments running concurrently (the 5 year Service Academy Graduate commitment and the ABM training 6 year commitment).
