DOD CATCH PROGRAM

CATCH allows victims who have filed either a *Restricted or certain Unrestricted Reports*, where the name of the suspect is not reported to law enforcement, and/or *No Report (SRI CATCH ENTRY)* to confidentially provide information about the suspect and/or incident in order to discover if the suspect in their report may have also assaulted another person.



.....

- Sexual Assault is defined as unwanted sexual contact characterized by use of force, physical threat, abuse of power, or when the victim does not or cannot consent
- Sexual Harassment is defined as a form of sex discrimination that involves unwelcome sexual advances, requests for sexual favors, and other verbal or physical conduct of a sexual nature

Reporting Options

Restricted Report: Allows for a service member, cadet, or adult dependent civilian to make a report and seek support services. These services include mental health and legal referrals or on-going victim advocacy. This will NOT trigger a law enforcement investigation and chain of command will NOT be notified. A SARC, VA, Chaplain, and health care provider, can assist with a restricted report.

Mandatory reporters include:

1. Commanders.
2. Chain of command (includes supervisors, supervisory chain, first sergeants, and senior enlisted advisors).
3. Instructors.
4. Law enforcement, including military security forces (both on and off-duty).

Unrestricted Report: Allows for a service member, cadet, or adult dependent civilian to make a report and seek services. This WILL trigger an investigation and chain of command WILL be notified. Once an unrestricted report is made, it cannot be converted back to a restricted report.
