We are committed to continuing to provide you with timely updates in regards to the evolving situation with COVID-19. Expect future direct communications from me about the situation and policy changes.

To date we are actively monitoring multiple sick cadets and permanent party members. While no one at USAFA has tested positive for COVID-19, we continue to take a conservative approach. We are prepared to take a number of actions depending on their conditions.

The safety of our USAFA community is our top priority. We realize that our COVID-19 policy guidelines will cause disruption, but the risk of not acting outweighs the inconvenience of temporary measures.

To that end we are beginning an orderly closure of USAFA to all visitors. USAFA will remain open to those on official business and all DoD ID card holders. We are closing all home sporting events to spectators. Additionally, we are reviewing options for working from home and teaching remotely. A letter is attached to this email that you may use with a commercial airline or travel company that may help to cancel or change a reservation.
